# AREA ATTRACTIONS

## THE STATUE OF LIBERTY

This statue, presented to the United States by France in 1884, welcomes visitors to New York City through New York Harbor and has come to symbolize freedom and liberty for generations of immigrants. Located on Liberty Island, the statue measures 305' 6" from the base of its pedestal to the tip of its torch, and weighs 225 tons.

Lady Liberty's face is over 8 feet tall and the 7 rays of her crown represent the seven continents of the world. The majority of the statue's exterior is 3/32 of an inch thick copper (less than the thickness of two pennies) and gets its green patina from the effect of natural weathering. The torch is the only part of the statue that does not have a copper exterior. During restoration that was completed in 1986, it was covered in a thin layer of 24k gold. The famous sonnet "New Colossus" by Emma Lazarus, written in 1883 as a tribute to the statue's universal message of hope and freedom, is inscribed on a bronze plaque inside the pedestal.

## ELLIS ISLAND MUSEUM

Ellis Island, a main point of entry for immigrants between 1892 and 1924, processed its last immigrant in 1954. Records indicate that the ancestors of more than 40% of Americans living today came through Ellis Island on the way to their new lives. Today, this museum includes documentation of immigration patterns, the ship's manifests and paperwork of those who entered here and many interesting histories on their lives after they arrived. The museum has a library where you can research your family history, discover famous people who came to the United States through Ellis Island, or discover new branches to add to your family tree.

## THE BROOKLYN BRIDGE

Spanning the East River, this National Historic Civil Engineering Landmark suspension bridge connects the boroughs of Brooklyn and Manhattan. This bridge was the first to use steel cable wire, and the first to use underwater explosives. Completed in May 1883, the 5,989-foot long Brooklyn Bridge was the longest suspension bridge in the world, and at the time, its towers were the tallest structures in the Western Hemisphere. The bridge was designed by chief engineer John A. Roebling, who later died from tetanus. The project was completed by his son, Washington Roebling, who, three years after beginning construction, developed a crippling illness called caisson's disease, known today as "the bends." Washington Roebling's wife, Emily, became the crucial point of communication between her husband and the engineer's in-site. On opening day, 150,300 people each paid a penny toll to cross the bridge.

## NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE

The largest securities exchange in the world traces its origins to the collaboration of 24 stock brokers who formed the Buttonwood Agreement in May 1792. In March of 1817, the organization was renamed the "New York Stock & Exchange Board" and in October 1934 the NYSE registered with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission as a national securities exchange. The number of members of the Exchange is fixed at 1,366, and new members may be admitted only when the membership of a retiring member is purchased. Membership "seats" may be purchased by individuals or firms. The highest price ever paid for a seat on the Exchange was \$4 million in the late 1990s. The Exchange reached its peak, closing at 14,164.53, on October 9, 2007.

## MUSEUMS

### *Museum of Jewish Heritage - A Living Memorial to the Holocaust*

Told from the perspective of the people who experienced the Holocaust. This museum recounts the daily pre-war lives and traditions of the Jewish communities, the unforgettably horrific events that destroyed them, and the resolute rebirth experienced in the years that followed.

### *National Museum of the American Indian, George Gustav Heye Center*

As part of the Smithsonian Institution, this museum presents the history, languages, customs, cultures, literature, art and more, of the indigenous peoples of the Western Hemisphere. Representing over 10,000 years of traditions and 800,000 works, the museum is located in the historic Alexander Hamilton U.S. Custom House (circa 1907).

# FIRE ALARM PROCEDURES

## Guest Room Smoke Alarm

The Wagner at the Battery is equipped with a fire prevention and detection system.

Included in this system are smoke detectors which are located in every guest room. When the smoke detector is activated in your room, the Security Department will be alerted simultaneously. Should the alarm in your room activate, the Security Department will dispatch personnel to your room. While these individuals are en route, Security will call you to check on the status of the alarm, arriving personnel will ensure your safety and ascertain the cause of the alarm. Each guest room is equipped with a separate detector system. Therefore, if the alarm in the room next to yours should be activated, it will not affect the detector in your room or cause an alarm to sound in your room.

For the hearing impaired, the hotel has special smoke detectors that can be placed in a guest room. These alarms are equipped with a flashing light in addition to the existing smoke detector alarm already in place. If you require such a device during your visit with us, please Touch O.

## General Fire Alarms

### What Types Of Alarms Does The Hotel Have?

In addition to the guest room alarms, there are alarms throughout the hotel. These alarms are located in public areas, guest floor hallways and certain work areas. These alarms are activated by five different devices; smoke detectors, heat detectors; pull boxes and water pressure sensors throughout the automatic sprinkler system, and rate of rise detectors.

## What Happens If One Of These Alarms Located In A Public Area Should Become Activated?

When a general alarm is activated in a public area, there will be an announcement to evacuate the affected area(s). If the area you are in should be evacuated, look for flashing lights in the ceiling. If you are in your guest room and hear an announcement, check the hallway outside of your guest room for these flashing lights. If these lights are not flashing, the area you are in is not affected by the alarm. If these lights are flashing, you need to evacuate by way of the nearest stairwell exit and proceed to the Lobby.

## What If I Hear The Alarm And The Announcement To Evacuate But The "Fire" Lights Are Not Flashing?

The sound of the alarm in one area of the hotel may drift through the stairwells and elevator shafts and be heard by guests in areas unaffected by the alarm. In such cases such as this, check to see if the "fire" lights are flashing. If the lights are not flashing stay where you are unless directed to do otherwise by the hotel management.

## What Happens If I Have To Evacuate?

If you are in an affected area, move to the nearest stairwell exit and evacuate upon reaching the Lobby Level. If you are in your room, take your key and close the door behind you. Move to the nearest stairwell exit (do not use the elevator) and descend. Never go up. When you reach the Lobby Level, exit the hotel.

Once the cause of the alarm has been identified and it has been determined to be safe to re-enter the hotel, the Fire Department will advise management. An announcement will then be made over the public address system advising that you may re-enter the hotel. Hotel staff will assist you. Remember, as soon as an alarm is activated, trained personnel automatically respond and notify the Fire Department.

Reminder: Please consult the fire evacuation chart which is located on the back of your guest room door.

We trust this information will help answer any questions you have concerning our emergency procedures and alarm system.
